1—English Colonies to American Republic:

***The New World* (NR: 172 min) (2008).**

An epic dramatization of Pocahontas' relationships with John Smith and John Rolfe.

***April Morning* (G: 120 min) (2001).**

The story of the day of April 19, 1775.

***John Adams* (PG-TV: 501 min) (2008).**

Chronicles the life of Founding Father John Adams.

2—Manifest Destiny:

***The Alamo* (PG-13: 137 min) (2004).**

Tale of 200 men and the fight for Texas independence.

***She Wore a Yellow Ribbon* (G: 103 min) (1949).**

Captain Nathan Brittles, on the eve of retirement, takes out a last patrol to stop an impending massive Indian attack. Encumbered by women who must be evacuated, Brittles finds his mission imperiled.

***Gettysburg* (PG, 271 min) (1993).**

Story of the 1863 Civil War Battle of Gettysburg.

***Lincoln* (PG-13: 150 min) (2013).**

This drama focuses on the final four months in office as this visionary leader pursues a course of action to end the Civil War.

***Dances with Wolves* (PG-13: 185 min) (1990).**

Story of a white soldier who posts in the 1870 Dakotas and becomes friends with the Lakota Sioux.

***Fort Apache* (NR: 128 min) (BW) (1940).**

The soldiers at Fort Apache may disagree with the tactics of their glory-seeking commander. But to a man they're duty bound to obey.
