## CTE Remote Learning Instructional Plan

Districts have provided families with educational options including in-person instruction and remote learning. We are prepared to support whichever option you have chosen with the approval of your sending district. However, it is important to understand that the foundation of CTE is hands-on learning and while we will provide the best possible remote coursework for students, there is no substitute for the experiential learning gained in the lab or workshop.

In the event that your family has chosen remote learning, the following expectations will be in place:

- Students must have internet access and a laptop or chromebook.
- Remote learning students should be available for instruction during CTE class hours.
  - AM session is 9 AM - 11 AM
  - PM session is 12 PM - 2 PM
- Teachers will use a combination of Google Classroom, online/paper textbooks and/or applicable software.
- The Zoom meeting platform will be used to provide interaction with the class.
- Teachers will establish attendance and online classroom expectations.
- A rubric will be used daily to track remote learner attendance and participation.
- Students in remote instruction will follow the same grading procedures as in-person peers.
- Students will be required to communicate with their teacher on a regular basis. Each teacher will determine the method and frequency of contact with remote learning students.

Return to in-person instruction will follow your district policies.
