Efforts to promote reading:

- **Promotion of SORA E-books and audiobooks-** Access information was shared with students across grade levels. This is available to students 24/7. The collection continues to grow and circulation of ebooks doubled this year.
- **Less strict loan limits/overdue policies to promote equity of access -** We continue to allow students to sign out books even if they have overdue books.
- **Book ownership** - Mrs. French gave students in grades PreK-5 a new paperback book to keep. The school also allowed all students in grades Prek-4 to pick a book from the book fair.
- **Summer Circulation/Summer Hours** - Students in grades 2 - 11 were able to sign books out for the summer. Over 100 books were signed out for the summer. The library will be open one morning a week during summer school for circulation. Last summer 106 books were circulated during summer school.
- **Dolly Parton Imagination Library** - HCS continues to be an official affiliate for this program. The program sends a book every month to children ages 0-5 at no cost to families.
