The Grades 3-8 ELA, math and science exams will start this coming week. They will be spread out to not over-test the kids in a short period of time and the exams should last through the middle of May.

I have also continued to try and figure out our lack of a physical therapist. There are 8 students who need PT during the week but without a provider, we have been unable to service this need.
